How much will it cost us to attend?

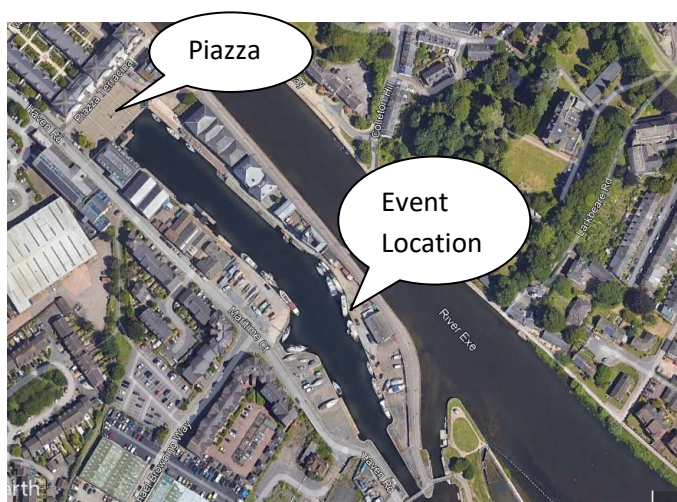
Not a penny!
